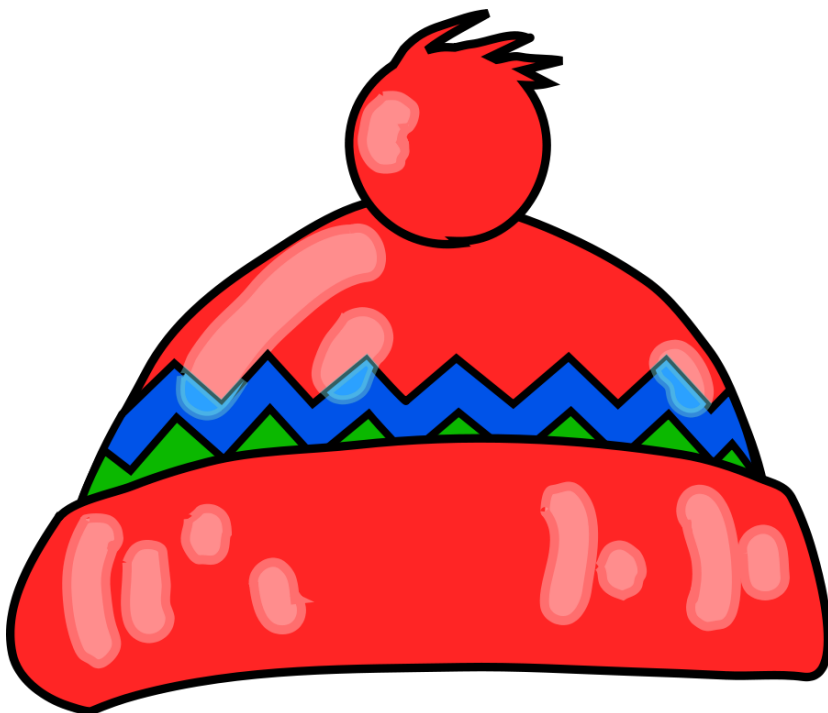
Welcome back! Happy New Year

Arrangement's for the start of the day and end of the day
