Reading, Writing and Maths Targets

Please check the back of your child's journal for their individual targets so you can support them at home.

Uniform

Please ensure your child wears the correct uniform on a daily basis. Cardigans and jumpers must have the school logo. Wearing ties in Y1 is optional. Long hair must be tied up and patterns in hair are not allowed. Please label all items of clothing-daily uniform, PE kits, coats, hats, school bags, lunch boxes. Only stud earrings may be worn. Earrings MUST be removed for PE.

Journals and Reading Books

Please read with your child every day, this MUST be recorded in your child's journal every time they read. It does not have to be the whole book, a few pages will be suitable for your child. Please also practice their weekly words to read and spell in their journals.

READING BOOKS AND JOURNALS MUST BE IN SCHOOL EVERY DAY.

It is your child's responsibly to get these out of their school bag and put them in the box on their table, so please remind them in the mornings.

Phonics Screening

All pupils nationally will have to read 40 words, real and nonsense words, as part of the phonics screening week. This will take place throughout the **week commencing Monday 10th June**. Please practice the words we send in their home learning books as these will help them to achieve a good pass mark. If you are unsure how to say the words, please ask a member of staff.

In addition, the weekly English or Maths must be completed every week and returned by the following Tuesday.
